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# Reminder!

## FFCRA GUIDELINES ARE STILL IN EFFECT UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2020

### EMERGENCY PAID SICK LEAVE

Employers with fewer than 500 employees and public agencies with at least one employee must provide full-time employees with up to 80 hours of paid sick leave if the employees are unable to work due to COVID-19. Part-time employees are entitled to paid sick leave based on the number of hours the employees work, on average, over a two-week period.



### EMERGENCY FAMILY AND MEDICAL LEAVE

The Emergency Family and Medical Leave Expansion Act amends the current FMLA, allowing leave for eligible employees who can't work because their minor child's school or childcare service is closed due to a COVID-19 emergency declared by a federal, state or local authority.

### QUALIFYING REASONS FOR LEAVE

1. The employee is subject to a federal, state, or local quarantine order related to COVID-19.
2. The employee has been advised by a health care provider to self-quarantine due to concerns related to COVID-19.
3. The employee is experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and seeking a medical diagnosis.
4. The employee is caring for an individual who is subject to either number 1 or 2 above.
5. The employee is caring for their child if the school or source of care has been closed or is unavailable, due to COVID-19 precautions.
6. The employee is experiencing any other substantially similar condition specified by the secretary of health and human services.

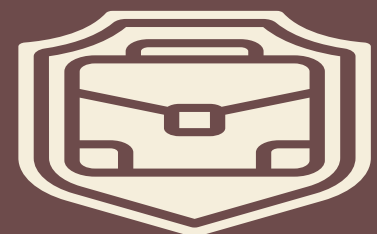


### PAY REQUIREMENTS

Paid sick leave must be paid at the employee's regular rate of pay, or minimum wage, whichever is greater, for leave taken for reasons 1-3 above. An Employee taking leave for reasons 4-6 may be compensated at two-thirds of his or her regular rate of pay, or minimum wage, whichever is greater. Tax credit will be granted to employers. You must follow proper reporting procedures.

### JOB PROTECTION

As with standard FMLA leave, the emergency leave is protected, meaning an employer must return the employee to the same or equivalent position upon their return. But, small employers with fewer than 25 employees are exempted if the position does not exist due to economic conditions or other changes in operating conditions that affect employment and are caused by a public health emergency.

Power wash the exterior walls in ALL areas, removing all efflorescence in full and any other dirt or sealant. Allow to dry for 48-72 hours. Minimum pressure washing shall not be less than 2000 PSI. Remove all caulking and sealant from all window sills and frame to glass connections. Seal the glass with a clear, multi-purpose silicone sealant unaffected by sunlight, rain, sleet, snow, UV, airborne contamination, ozone or temperature extremes caulking. Seal the frames with Garland Tuff-Stuff caulking or equal. Existing weep holes shall not be covered. Install new 22-gauge metal eyebrows over all windows, attached to the blocks with pre-drilled holes, butyl tape backing and concrete screws. The intent of the surface mounted flashing is to move the water off the windows as it comes down the wall. Reseal all cracks and concrete wall joints with a single-component polyether sealant which allows for future movement. Repair concrete broken area at the corner near the exterior outdoor caged recreation area. Approximately 3' x 3' repair utilizing a fast setting concrete patch material. With a dry and clean surface, seal the exterior walls in all areas, including the interior of the caged patios. Seal with an elastomeric coating for CMU wall systems. There shall be a minimum of two (2) application passes and a minimum of one (1) gallon per square foot applied per manufacture's recommendation. The east facing walls shall receive three applications of sealant. A water intrusion test shall be performed on the east facing walls to ensure the water is repelled. Contractor is responsible for all equipment, and job site requirements to be able to work in a secured prison.

I have covered the great job CSLB is doing with the restrictions inherent with Covid-19 guidelines. There are however some issues and the first contractor has discovered one of these problems. While your fingerprints are yours alone a 'copy' isn't enough for a contractor's license, followed by an out-of-state question with a somewhat 'specialized' answer...

Q: I was the Responsible Managing Officer (RMO) for a company several years ago and the Company went out of business. My buddy started a contracting business and he wanted me to be the RMO on his new company license. We submitted all the necessary paperwork for a Waiver application. The CSLB sent us a deficiency letter stating that I needed to satisfy some outstanding Civil Judgements relating to the former business where I was an RMO. I don't understand why that has anything to do with this current situation. The former company has not been in business for several years now. I've tried to reach the CSLB but have only been able to leave messages. Do you have any suggestions for me?

A: While the CSLB is still open and conducting business, due to the COVID-19 situation many of the staff have been working from home, so it can be difficult to get someone on the phone. Even though your previous employer is no longer in business, the fact that you are still "associated" with the company as their RMO, their judgments/citations/etc. will follow you around to any other Contractor's licenses you are associated with or attempting to associate with. I would suggest that you Disassociate from your former company in order to move forward with your current venture. Get back to me if you need help with that.

Q: I spoke with you last month about obtaining a new Contractor's License and you were helpful enough to answer all my questions and inform me about the licensing process. You had mentioned the need for all individuals listed on the license application to get fingerprinted and how the timing process to obtain a license is greatly reduced if all individuals get fingerprinted in California via Live Scan. One question I forgot to ask is that I was fingerprinted for my Real Estate license in CA a

couple of years ago. Is that sufficient if I just inform the CSLB to cross reference the fingerprint submittal?

A: Unfortunately, no. All individuals listed on the license application are required to get fingerprinted specifically for the CSLB with the forms the CSLB sends to you after you submit the license application.

Q: Our company currently holds Contractor's Licenses in many States and we are looking to get licensed in California. I've looked up several of our competitors' licenses, and some have an "A" license, some have a "B" license, and some hold "C" class licenses (which seems to reflect specialty work). If we were to obtain the "A" license, does that cover us for all of the other classifications of licenses?

A: While many people think that, no, this is not the case. The "A" license is for General Engineering work, which involves heavy civil construction and primarily fixed works, and any other work involving specialized engineering skills (roadwork, bridges, tunnels, underground work, etc.). The "B" is a General Building license that includes everything it takes to build a structure from the ground up, *with the requirement of performing at least two unrelated trades* on each job (framing, painting, electrical, plumbing, flooring, etc.). You are correct regarding the "C" classifications. They are specialty classifications and they are designated for Contractors whose principal business involves performing specialized building trades.

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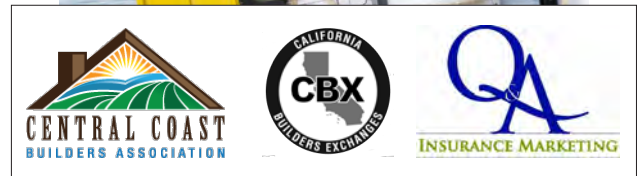

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# Safety Tip of the Week

## SWING RADIUS

To prevent the backhoe or crane from striking or crushing employees, always barricade areas within the “swing radius” of the rear of the crane’s rotating superstructure.

This barrier can consist of orange reflective traffic cones or barrels which marks and warns both the crew members and the uninformed public of the dangers of these machines.

Each operator is responsible for the placement of the swing radius barriers when the machine is being operated. These markers are to be kept with the machine when not in operation and are to be placed by the operator when making the walk around safety check, prior to operation.

All employees are to be instructed in the purpose of the barriers and no work is to be conducted inside the barriers when the machine is in operation. If repairs to the machine or maintenance is required, the machine should not be in operation. If work is necessary adjacent to the machine, the operator should stop and assist in the work.

Equipment operators can work to prevent accidents. Each operator should develop a habit of walking around their equipment before operation. Check the equipment itself and the area where you will be operating the equipment. Are there any obstacles such as depressions or poles that might affect how you operate your machine...are the barricades sufficient and still in place.

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# Tip de Seguridad en Español

## Radios de Oscilación

Para prevenir que el backhoe o grúa le pegue o aplaste a empleados, siempre ponga barricadas que protejan el "radio de oscilación" detras de la grúa cuando la estructura está en rotación.

Esta barrera, puede consistir de conos anaranjados de tráfico reflectivos o barriles que marcan y advierten a los miembros del equipo y al público no informado de los peligros de estas máquinas.

Cada operador es responsable por la colocación de las barreras de radio de oscilación cuando se opera la máquina. Estos marcadores deben de guardar se con la máquina cuando no está en operación y deben de ponerse, por el operador, cuando se hace la revisión de seguridad de la máquina, antes de operarla.

Todos los empleados deben ser informados del propósito de las barreras y nada de trabajo se debe de hacer dentro de las barreras cuando la máquina está en funcionamiento. Si se requieren reparaciones a la máquina o se requiere mantenimiento, la máquina no debe estar en funcionamiento. Si se necesita trabajo enseguida de la máquina, el operador debe pararla y ayudar en el trabajo.

Los operadores de equipo pueden trabajar para prevenir accidentes. Cada operador debe desarrollar el hábito de caminar alrededor de su equipo antes de operarlo. Revise el equipo mismo y el área donde operará el equipo. ¿Hay cualquier obstáculo tal como depresiones o postes que puede afectar cómo opera su máquina?...las barricadas ¿Son suficientes y en su lugar?
